### SAS Clinic – Bugolobi

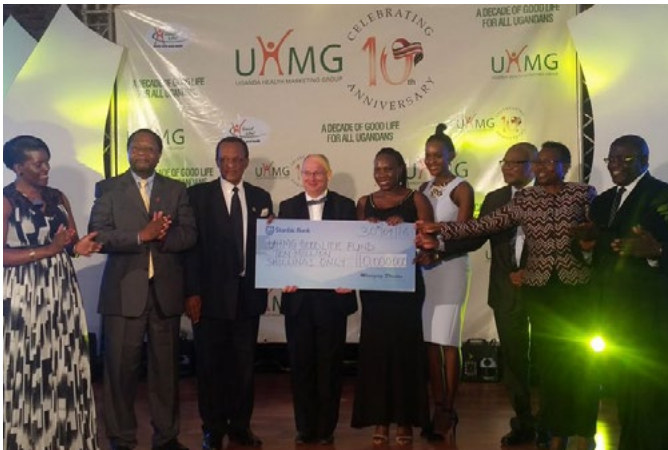

## UHMG Marks 10 years, launches the Good Life Fund to support priority



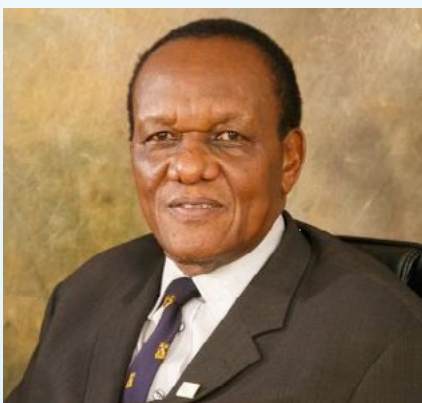

As UHMG marked 10 years of delivering good health to all Ugandans on 30th September 2016, the major highlight was the launch of a Good Life Fund. The Fund is a Sustainability initiative that will pool complementary sources of financing from the private sector to support health interventions in areas that are critical, emerging, and under-funded, yet they contribute largely to current mortality rates. These largely fall in the areas of Maternal, Child Health and Non communicable diseases. According to WHO Uganda country profile, non communicable diseases (NCDs) were responsible for 27% of all deaths in 2014. During the ceremony, symbolic messages from the guest of honour, Hon. Ruth Aceng, Minister of Health and UHMG Board Members were echoed. Key among the messages was the call for health advocates to embrace the Public Private Partnership initiatives by the Ministry of Health and remain focused on its vision of a good life to all Ugandans.

After Careful consideration, the Board of Directors appointed Prof. George B. Kirya as Patron for the Good Life Fund (2016-2019).

### UHMG Leads on the first ever Social Marketing Colloquium.

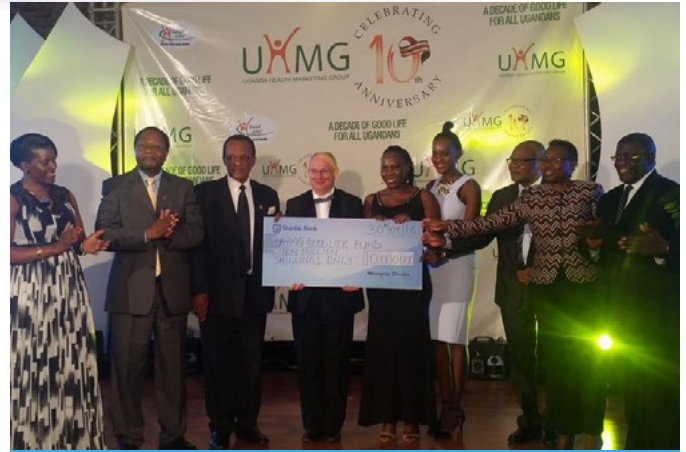
