### **Program / Department Summary**

Uganda Healthcare Federation with support from Private Sector Foundation Uganda under Young Africa Works Project with MasterCard Foundation aims to implement immediate relief, recovery and resilience interventions under the COVID-19 PSFU Response Project in strengthening, organizing and mobilizing the private sector to provide Ugandans with the option of obtaining high-quality health services from private health providers (PHP).
